2015/2016 was again a very successful season with my highlights being:

- Dan Jacobson qualifying for his first Australian team, being selected as a member of the Junior Pan Pacific Championships team that will compete in Hawaii later this year in August.
- Connor Eade winning gold at Open Water Age Nationals in the boys 13 years 5km swim as well as making the finals in two of his events at Age Nationals.
- Dan Jacobson winning silver at Age Nationals in the boys 17 years 400m freestyle as well as making a number of finals.
- Rebecca Jacobson winning bronze at Age Nationals in the girls 14 years 200m freestyle as well as making a number of finals.
- Finished 11th overall at the Queensland Swimming Championships and 47th at the Australian Age Nationals.
- 74% of swims at Queensland Swimming Championships being swum in personal best times – the highest conversion rate of any club with more than 20 swimmers attending the Championships!
- Third place in the Brisbane Swimming Premier Division.
- A great sign on day with special guest Emily Seebohm.
- Increase in our club size by close to 30% year on year.
- The continued growth of the junior dolphin events at club night – this is the basis for a strong and growing club in the future!
- Conducted three very well attended and successful swim meets.
- Provided swimmer and parent educational activities including information sessions on nutrition, swimming specific physiotherapy and sports psychology.
- The team travel meet via chartered bus to the Miami Spring Meet.
- Wonderful Christmas break up party – particularly the adults vs kids relay!!
- National Qualifiers Dinner – a memorable evening and a continuing tradition.
- And lastly, the purchase and installation of new starting blocks.

Sign-On Day

The 2015/2016 season kicked off with Sign On day in September with special guest Emily Seebohm (thank you Laurel Scott for arranging this for us). She was so friendly and chatted to all the kids while she signed autographs and posed for photos.

Sign on Day was promoted through quite a few school newsletters (thank you Sharon Peck for arranging) and also in the local papers. As a result of this promotion, we had more new members sign up on the day than in previous years. We also had our club brochure redesigned and printed in time for sign on day.

The entire committee and all of the coaches were in attendance. Thank you to Jenny and Evan Woodward once again for arranging a delicious breakfast for everyone to enjoy. It was great to see some of the younger swimmers so excited about joining swim club and imagining that one day, they could be as successful as Emily Seebohm. Junior Dolphins

Once again this season, the Junior Dolphin level of swimmer was continued (and will be rolled out to the rest of the country later this year). This level gives younger swimmers the chance to join swim club to see how much fun it can be. It also gives them the opportunity to improve their swimming skills in a non-competitive and supportive environment. Junior Dolphins are aged 7 and under and entitles them to free membership to the club until they turn 8. Last year you had to be 7 on the day you signed up to become a Junior Dolphin. This year, as long as you were 7 on 1 July 2015, you could become a Junior Dolphin. All Junior Dolphins were also sent a goodie bag by Swimming Qld. By the end of this season, we had 45 Junior Dolphin members who will hopefully continue to swim next season.

Competitive 8yrs Swimmers

This season saw the introduction of another new level of swimmer – Competitive 8 year old swimmers. This level was introduced to encourage swimmers who were Junior Dolphins last year to continue swimming. It offered these 8 year old children the same benefits as a Competitive swimmer, for half the price. Instead of membership for \$168, it was only \$84. We finished the season with 21 members in this category.

The introduction of the above levels of swimmers has resulted in a large increase in club membership from previous years which is a great foundation for these younger swimmers to gain the love of swimming that our older swimmers have.

Club Lane

Once again this season, all membership renewals were done online using the Club Lane system through Swimming Qld. It is a quick and easy way to join and renew membership and allows the entire family to renew at the same time instead of one at a time. Many of the manual processes are now automated and accessible to members. Members can choose their own password, update their own change of contact details and download their payment receipts. Members can now also use their login details to do online meet nominations. In the last few months, My Lane has been introduced which allows each swimmer to:

- View your swim results and track them against Personal Bests and Qualifying Times
- View your upcoming meets and enter them online via the portal
- Check your JX status
- See News from your Club, State and Swimming Australia all in one place
- Receive information on membership offers and discounts from sponsors
- Add a photo to your personal profile and highlight your personal interests
- Track your membership details and payments, &
- Technical Officials will be able to view their accreditations

We had a record number of swimmers competing at QLD State Championships with 61 swimmers making up the 30 relay teams. At BSA relay day we had 63 swimmers competing in 46 teams. Brisbane Swimming Association (BSA) Premiership Competition

Each year, Brisbane Swimming conducts a series of championship events across various disciplines which in their total comprise the BSA Premiership Competition. Clubs earn points, based on their swimmers' performances, at each event, with each club's accumulated points across all of events being used to determine the top clubs in each division.

Brisbane Swimming Association Premiership Results

During Brisbane Swimming championship events, points are awarded to the top 16 swimmers in each event, within their specific division. At the conclusion of each championship event, each club is awarded points according to their overall position within their division at the event.

For the past few years Albany Creek has finished in the top four within the Premier Division (the highest division within the Premiership Competition) and reached 2nd last year. This year, thanks to all the swimmers who competed at BSA meets finished in 3rd place, just narrowly missing out on a 2nd place finish.

Congratulations to all the swimmers and to all the coaches who prepared, trained and supported our swimmers all season.

Each year the swim season culminates with Australian National Championships for both Open Water and Pool swimming events.

This year our swimmers have performed at numerous National Events making their coach, club and parents proud of their achievements. To reach the qualifying standards at a national level means that you are often ranked in the top 25 swimmers in Australia, for each age group. This is by no means an easy feat.

Albany Creek was also well represented at the **2016 Australian National Age & Open Water Championships** by the following swimmers:

Junior Excellence (JX) Program

The Australian Junior Excellence Program (JX) recognises, rewards and encourages junior swimmers who, through their development of aquatic skills and fitness, achieve a high standard of swimming excellence. The Program now also recognises the achievements of SWD and OWS swimmers.

Under the Program, swimmers aged from 9 to 13 years who accomplish times set by Swimming Australia qualify at Green, Bronze, Silver or Gold standard, depending on their performance/s during the season

For doing so, qualifiers receive special recognition by way of:

- 9 and 10 year olds: JX cap, JX Certificate of Achievement, JX motivational poster signed by the National Youth Coach and members of the Australian Swim Team, featuring elite Australian swimmers, McDonald's voucher and a letter of congratulations
- 11 to 13 year olds: JX shirt, JX Certificate of Achievement, signed by the National Youth Coach and members of the Australian Swim Team, JX motivational poster featuring elite Australian swimmers, McDonald's voucher, JX DVD and a letter of congratulations
- Publication of their names on the Swimming Australia website

Australia is one of the top swimming nations in the world and by achieving the Green, Bronze, Silver or Gold JX standard, junior swimmers are on the pathway to international success.

JX Green means that you completed at least one tier 4 time in any event.

JX Bronze means that you have completed at least one tier 3 time in any event.

JX Silver means that you have completed at least one tier 2 time in any event.

JX Gold means that you have completed at least one tier 1 time in any event for 9-10 year-olds, or a tier 1 time in any two events for 11-13 year-olds.
